Qualifications for Position: Ph.D. in Criminal Justice, Criminology, or closely related discipline with documented specialization in Criminal Justice or Criminology from an accredited institution with a strong commitment to teaching, academic research, and service.

ABDs will be considered if requirements for the Ph.D. are completed by the start date. The successful candidate must demonstrate a commitment to quality teaching, the ability to conduct research and publish, and the ability to enhance the department. We seek a candidate with an active research agenda and the ability to teach courses within our programs' core requirements, although area of specialization is open.

This position requires a commitment to collegiality, high-impact educational practices, scholarship and creative activity, professional development, academic citizenship, and community engagement. Interest in sponsored research that opens avenues for our students is highly desirable. The successful candidate will teach face-to-face and online courses. Evidence of a commitment to diversity is expected. Start date is August 2019. Salary is commensurate with experience and pending available funding. Summer teaching assignments are offered.- Review of applications will begin on February 21, 2019, and will continue until the position is filled.
