DIRECTOR-AT-LARGE Attends mid-year and annual meetings of the Association in order to participate in the decision-making process of the Board of Directors and to play a role in providing general policy direction for the SCJA. They each chair one of the association's standing committees. Term of office is for three (3) years.
