The Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminal Justice invites applications for a full-time lecturer position beginning 15 August 2023. This position is for on-campus, in-person teaching. We seek applicants with experience teaching criminal justice. The successful candidate will be able to offer introductory and upper-division courses in the criminal justice curriculum.

The position will be appointed with a one-year contract, renewable annually. The position includes the possibility of promotion to Senior Lecturer and Principal Lecturer with corresponding increases to contract lengths of three and five years. Primary duties include teaching up to four courses, or equivalent, per semester and actively contributing to the undergraduate teaching mission of the department.

Clemson University is a public land-grant institution with 20,000 undergraduates and 5,500 graduate students. Clemson University is located in Upstate South Carolina. Main campus sits on 1,400 acres in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains, along the shores of Lake Hartwell.
